



Situate in White Deer township Union [late Berks] County. Surveyed the 20th day of September, 1832 by virtue of an Order granted to Samuel Mitchel dated the 3^d day of April, 1769, No. 1340. Containing One hundred & forty three Acres with the Usual Allowance of Six Per Cent &c.

Note. The same tract of land was Surveyed the 9th day of June 1769. for William McDowel in pursuance of his Order dated the 3^d day of April, 1769, No. 698. And now owned & occupied [after a tedious lawsuit] by James Miller in right of the said William McDowel.
