


Late John Brandon.

Surveyed the 20th day of September, 1832, by virtue of an Order granted to Aaron Vaneken dated the 3<sup>d</sup> day of April, 1769, No. 1785, containing One hundred & forty three Acres with the usual Allowance of Six per cent &c.

Note. The above mentioned tract of land was surveyed the 9th day of June 1769, for William McDowell by virtue of his order dated the 3<sup>d</sup> day of April, 1769, No. 698. Now owned and occupied by James Miller in right of the said William McDowell.
