



Whereas George Fry made a purchase of a tract of land to wit A. and B. are parts of a tract of land originally Survey'd to George Ulrich Fisher by virtue of a warrant dated the twenty seventh day of March 1737. A. contains A<sup>s</sup> 9.3. and B. Contains A<sup>s</sup> 17.16. C. is the larger part of another tract of land originally Survey'd to the said George Ulrich Fisher the warrant dated the <sup>25<sup>th</sup></sup> seventh day of March 1738. C. containing A<sup>s</sup> 151.141. - The above described tract or piece of land situate in Rockland Township Berks County containing in the whole one hundred and seventy eight acres and the allowance of six P. Cent. Survey'd the 30<sup>th</sup> day of March A.D. 1790 for George Fry.
