


Nicholas Martz



By Virtue of a Warrant granted to Adam Helwig, bearing date the nineteenth day of June A.D. 1754 there was surveyed the above tract of land, situate in Longswamp township, Berks County, Containing one hundred and seven acres, twenty eight perches and allowance of six Pct for roads &c.

from an Original Draft of James Scull, a former Deputy Surveyor of Berks County, remaining filed in the Deputy Surveyor's Office of said County.
