



The part marked A. is an interference of a tract of 147 9/16^{RS} and all^{ce} patented to Jacob Glantz in right of W^m. Cooper, the 17th Aug. 1809, now owned and possessed by John Miller (storekeeper) in Mt. pleasant Township, Adams County.

The part marked B. is an interference of a tract of 23 9/16^{RS} & all^{ce} part of a larger Tract patented to John Donnell 15th March, 1815, now owned by John Miller aforesaid, in Mt. pleasant Township.
