

Situate in Brunsweig Township Schuylkill County Containing 44 A 125 E 87 allowance of six per cent for Roads & Surveyed on the 22^d day of November A.D 1831 by Virtue of an Application N^o 1320 dated the 3^d day of February A.D 1766 — entered by Robert Stephens — To the Hon^{ble} the Board By Geo Pratin — of Property of Pennsy^a

The lines of the Red Survey were made on Robert Actual Survey. Stephens Appl^c N^o 1320. and the yellow Survey was made Present owners, on Richard Stephens W^t dated the 21 Oct. 1751. in the year Christian & Daniel 1780 as the line trees shew. there is no Draught shewing the dates of Survey of the two Surveys nor of the Blue Survey. — the Blue Survey was made on a Wart to George Custard. dated between 1750 & 1760 — cannot find out the date. the impr^t on the Red & yellow Surveys is only some cleared land — the impr^t on the Blue Survey was commenced about 37 years ago. —
