

Warrant 31st May 1762. to George Goosehorn, including his
improvement —

In pursuance of the several Acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the principal and interest due to the Commonwealth from Persons holding Lands by Virtue of Locations or other Office Titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government and for other purposes I have this day located and surveyed Warrant 31st May 1762 to George Goosehorn, on lands situate in Manheim Township, and have found the Interferences as represented in enclosed Diagram —
