



Situate in Lower Chancery township in the County of York Containing within the black lines as above represented 78<sup>ac</sup> & 45<sup>rs</sup> of the usual allowance &c. Surveyed on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of August 1831 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Charles Bradshaw for 100<sup>ds</sup> dated the 4 day of April 1754, and by virtue of the Contract entered into with the Board of Property.

Report the above Land is covered by a Survey of 225<sup>ac</sup> made and returned in pursuance of a warrant granted to John Campbell Farmer dated the 19 day of May 1752. the dotted lines represent the balance of said Survey the whole now owned and occupied by John Sinclair.
