

Situate in Point Township Northumberland County including his imprt on the E: Side of the W. branch of Susquehanna about 21/2 miles above fort Augusta Surveyed the 15th day of October 1835 by Virtue of an Order Nº 1921 dated the 3rd day of April 1769 granted to William Walker Containing two hundred & ten acres & twenty four perches, and the usual allowance of Six Per Cent &s. Note The same tract of land was surveyed the -day of - for John Musser in pursuance of his order Nº 3741 dated the 21st day of August 1769 and is now owned and occupied by John Frick in right of said John Musser.
