

Situate in Point Township Northumberland County on the west side of the N.E. branch of Susquehanna-near the point of the forks Joining at 500 acre tract ordered to be Surveyed for the Proprietors extending up & near said branch about a mile Surveyed the 13th day of October 1835 by Virtue of anorder N° 1958 dated the 3rd day of April 1769 granted to Philip Dean Containing three hundred and thirty acres & the usual allowance of Six Per Cent.

Note the same tract of land was Surveyed the —day of —for Sarah Lowden in pursuance of her Order dated the 5th day of July 1769 Nº3614 and is now owned & occupied by various persons as out lots near the Town of Northumberland in Right of Said Sarah Lowden.
