

In pursuance of an Application granted to James McCallister Jr. No<sup>o</sup> 2088 dated 3<sup>d</sup> of April 1769 Surveyed the above described tract of land on the 15<sup>th</sup> of January 1829 containing three hundred and fifty four acres four perches and the allowance proportioned at six percent for Roads &c Situate on the four mile run near its confluence with the Loyalhanna - in Ligonier Township Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania.
