

The lines of the above Survey, appear by the line trees to have been made in 1769.— two Warrt were afterwards granted to Walter P. Brady & Thomas Grant dated in 1793 and Surveyed according to the yellow lines above represented. the said Warrts were granted for land in the County of Northumber land the Impr<sup>ts</sup> are recent.
