

Situate in Peach Bottom late Fawn township in the County of York Containing as above set forth 150½ a<sup>s</sup> and the usual allowance Originally surveyed on the 18<sup>th</sup> of April 1757 in pursuance of a warrant granted to William Stalworth for 20 a dated the 6<sup>th</sup> day of August 1753 and now this 16<sup>th</sup> day of June 1831 the same is returned by virtue of the Contract entered into with the Board of Property.

Report - This Land is now owned and occupied by James Ramsey Jun<sup>r</sup> and was surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to James Ramsey. A Trial was had before the Board of Property 4 December 1800. Wm Robison Vs. James Ramsey and the decision then in favour of Ramsey (See proceedings &c.)
