


**FORM NO 1.**

John Hossack's  
other Land



In pursuance of the several Acts of Assembly directing the recovery  
of the Principal and interest due to the Commonwealth from Persons  
holding lands by virtue of locations or other office titles issued from  
or under the Proprietary Government and for other purposes, I have this  
day located and surveyed Warrant 30<sup>th</sup> June 1774 granted to John  
Hassock for 50<sup>ac</sup> of Land in Cumberland Township on Lands situate  
in Cumberland Township (now Mennallen) and have found the interferences  
as represented in the enclosed diagram. Witness my hand.

November 30<sup>th</sup> 1837.

conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of  
February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused
