


FORM NO 1.



Situate in Codorus township in the County of York. That part within the black lines Containing 100 as 94^a and the allowance &c. was Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Anthony Moul for 50^a dated the 18th day of October 1751. The part of the same within the red lines Containing about 42 as 80^a was Surveyed and said to be returned and Patented on a Warrant granted to William Scott for 40^a dated the 12th June 1788 and the part within the yellow lines embraced within a survey (as represented by the Dotted Lines) made and held under a Maryland Patent granted to Andrew Hershey. The whole tract owned and in possession of John Martin & Jacob Hershey in Paradise town^p. - Moul's Warrant said to be abandoned - Reported &c 18th November 1828.
