

Warrant 10th Sept^r 1750 to Archibald Mahon for 50^{ac} on a branch of Bermudian Creek in Huntingdon Town^{sh}

In pursuance of the several Acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the principal and interest due to the Commonwealth from Persons holding Lands by Virtue of Locations or other Office Titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government and for other purposes, I have this day located & surveyed Warrant granted 10th Septem^r 1750 to Archibald Mahon for 50^{ac} on a Branch of Bermudian Creek in Huntingdon Township or Lands situate as aforesaid & have found the Interferences as represented in the enclosed Diagram - Witness my hand
