 of the principal and interest due to the Commonwealth from Persons holding  
 Lands by virtue of Locations or other Office Titles issued from or under the  
 Proprietary Government and for other purposes I have this day located and  
 surveyed Warrant granted 19<sup>th</sup> May 1752 to George Black for 100 <sup>as</sup> on lands  
 in Mountpleasant Township Adams County and have found the Interferences  
 as represented in the enclosed Diagram. Witness my hand
