

By Virtue of a Warrant under the hands of the Commissioners of Property and the Seal of the Province bearing date the 20th day of the 3^d mon^r 1703 for Resurveying of Lands in the County of Chester There was Resurveyed in the 4th mo. in the year aforesaid unto Elizabeth Cookson a tract of land in Middletown in the County aforesaid beginning at a Walnut tree by Ridley Creek at a corner of Hollingsworths Land thence South fifty five degrees west by the said Hollingsworths ^{worths} Line three hundred and thirty six perches to a white oak thence south thirty five degrees east Seventy Six perches to a Spanish Oak Then by Rich^d Crosby's land North fifty five degrees east two hundred forty six perches to a white oak by a Run. Then by the said Run Seventy Six Perches to the 5^d ^{by y^e several Courses of the 5^d Creek.} Ridley Creek - thence ~~the same~~ to y^e place of beginning Containing one hundred and fifty acres
