

 hereof with six months Interest for ye same. and the yearly Quitt^rt of one
 Shilling Sterling P. hundred forever. These are to Authorize and Require thee
 to Survey or cause to be Survey'd to the said Hubert Cassel according to the
 Method of Townships the said quantity of two hundred and fifty Acres of
 Vacant Land in the place afores^d and make return thereof into the Secre-
 taries Office With which Agreemt if the said Hubert shall duly comply thy
 said Survey shall be valid otherwise the same to be void as if it had never
 been made nor this Warr^t ever Granted. Given under our hands and Seal
 of the Province at Philad^{ia} the 15th day of the 12th month A.D. 1717
