Lay'd out for Edward Cartledg 150 Akers of Land Leying upon the west side of darbey Creek begining at a marked white oke standing by darbey Creek being the Corner tree of thomas whidbey thence W ~~E~~ W into y^e woods to a marked Cheasnutt then N NW 36 Perches to a marked Red oke then N E E 20 Perches to a black oke from thence E.N.E. by a line of marked Red trees to a Red oke standing by darbey creek and downe the Creek to the first marked tree.
