


By Order from the Commissioners for setting out Lands to ye Planters  
in Pensilvaria I hereby Authorize thee to Survey and lay out one hundred  
and fifty Akers as head right for James Croft mary his wife and Hester  
theyr daughter and joyne it to Joseph Knights Hundred Akers <sup>in a reasonable long square</sup> on the  
backe side of thomas Paschalls Lands neare unto Skookekill River so as  
more heade Rights may with Conveniency be added thereto and returne to  
me a true duplicate of ye field worke and protracted figure which is  
to remaine in my office dated 14<sup>th</sup> of 7 mo: 82
