



Warrant dated 11<sup>th</sup> Augt 1755 to William Wierman for 25 acres.

In pursuance of the several Acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the Principal and interest due to the Commonwealth from Persons holding Lands by virtue of Locations or other Office Titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government and for other purposes I have this day located and surveyed Warrant granted 11<sup>th</sup> Augt 1755 to William Wierman for 25 acres between Bermudian and Cononago Creek on Lands situate as aforesaid in Huntington Township and have found the interferences as represented in the enclosed diagram
