

Situate in Lower Chanceford township in the County of York Containing as above set forth 9 as 29 es and the usual allowance &c. Located on the 22 d of August 1831 in pursuance of a warrant granted to John Robison for 12 a dated the 34 day of December 1773 and by virtue of the Contract entered into with the Board of Property.

Report The above land is entirely embraced in a Survey of 1650 92 perches made on two warrants granted to Henry Robison dated the 22 d of March 1763 and patented to Joseph Smith on the 13 th day of September 1810. John Robison purchased from Henry Robison under whose right it is now daimed & occupied by Joseph Smith Dan! Small --
