

 the 22<sup>d</sup> day of November 1773 Containing fifty nine Acres & two tenths with the  
 Usual allowance of Six  $\frac{1}{4}$  Cent &c Resurveyed the 1<sup>st</sup> day of August 1833 Accord-  
 ing with the Original lines and found the Survey &c Correct. ~

Note. ~ On the 1<sup>st</sup> day of July 1786 a Warrat was granted to Thomas  
 Hartley Esq a Survey was made in pursuance thereof which  
 included the tract of of land above described, the same is  
 now owned and occupied by Daniel Spiegelmyer in right of  
 the said Thomas Hartley
