

Note. ~ The above tract is part of a larger tract of land which was Surveyed the 14<sup>th</sup> day of October 1774 to George Irwin in right of John Rutherford by Virtue of his Warrant dated the 6<sup>th</sup> day of August 1773 And owned & Occupied by James Moore in right of the s<sup>d</sup>.
