

By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries Dated the Third day of September 1734. Surveyed unto Jacob Meshlin a tract of Land Situate in Frederick Township in the County of Philad? Beginning at a post in a line of Humphrey Murry & John Budds land thence by land of Christian Taylor North Nine degrees East thirty Eight perches to a post thence by land of Jacob Faux North Seventy nine degrees East Ninety five perches to a post thence by 5th Faux's land and Vacant Land South East one hundred and Twenty two perches to a Black Oak Sapling thence by Vacant land South West one hundred and Nine perches to a post thence North West one hundred and Fifty two perches to the place of Beginning Containing one hundred Acres with the usual allowance of Six & Cent. ~
