


**FORM NO 1.**



Draught of a tract of land situate in Letterkenny township  
Franklin county, containing two hundred and thirty nine acres  
and forty perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c.  
granted Joseph Alexander.  
Was surveyed 28th of May 1767 on an order of 200 acres,  
bearing date 9th December 1766 No. 2117. Examined and  
returned in pursuance of a contract with the Board of Prop-  
erty for carrying into effect the several acts of Assembly  
relating to unpatented Lands under proprietary rights &c.  
27th August 1829.
