

on warrant dated the 15th day of January 1794. This tract inter-
feres one hundred and fifty seven acres and twenty perches
with the John Patterson survey. Thomas Mitchenor conveyed to
Gideon H. Wells & Robert Morris who conveyed to John McGahen
who conveyed to George McGrumb the present owner.
No. 2. represented by green lines represents part of a survey made
for Robert Irvin on warrant dated the 15th day of January 1794
This survey interferes twenty one acres and one hundred & fifty perches
with the John Patterson survey. Robert Ervin conveyed to Gideon H.
Wells and Robert Morris who conveyed to John McGahen who conveyed
to George McGrumb the present owner.
