



In pursuance of a contract of the first of Novr: 1827 with the Members  
of the Board of Property of the State of Penn<sup>g</sup> and the authority therein  
stated, there was surveyed & calculated by virtue of a warrant granted by the  
Proprietary Government unto John Byrnes the 11<sup>th</sup> of August 1773, the a-  
bove tract of land, situate in Plum<sup>b</sup> township Allegheny County, con-  
taining Three hundred two acres & thirty four perches & allowance  
for roads &c.

right of Michael Chew on wt. of 23<sup>d</sup> July 1773, surveyed 23<sup>d</sup> Sept: 1773.
