


FORM NO. 1.



The dotted lines and the letters A B in the above diagram represent a survey made to William Fraimer on the 7<sup>th</sup> of May 1828 a return whereof is herewith enclosed the land has been previously surveyed and appropriated by Robert McJemsey Junr at this time therein stated. It <sup>is</sup> owned and occupied by Joseph Harbison who claims under the title to McJemsey. I could not ascertain that there was or is any person holding or claiming the land under William Fraimers title.
