


FORM NO 1.



The shaded lines in the above diagram represent a survey made to Hugh ^{Mc} Henry on the 22^d of April 1828 a return whereof is herewith enclosed. The dotted lines above represent two surveys made upon new purchase warrants No^s 326 & 118 under which the land is now considered to be held it is occupied by Arch'd Kinter who settled as a squatter, owner not known. It is not known that any person claims under the title of Hugh Mc Henry.
