

In pursuance of a contract of the first of Nov<sup>r</sup> 1827 with the members of the Board of Property of the state of Penna. & the authority therein stated, there was surveyed & calculated by virtue of a warrant granted by the Proprietary Government unto John McFerson the 26<sup>th</sup> of Nov<sup>r</sup> 1773. the above tract of land situate in Plum<sub>b</sub> township Allegheny county. Containing two hundred & fifty acres one half & allowance of six p<sup>t</sup> ac.
