

In pursuance of the Several acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the principal and interest due to the Commonwealth from persons holding lands by virtue of Locations or other office titles issued from or under the proprietary Government and by authority from the Board of Property I have this 9th day of April 1828 Surveyed the above described tract of Three hundred and twenty acres and allowance of six per cent on the heads of Plumb creek adjoining lands of Peter Backman Herman Leroy Jan Linklean and others Situate in Matsoning township Indiana County By virtue of a warrant granted to Frederick Stone on the 25th of January 1774
