

The above tract is an Interference of a tract of 33<sup>00</sup> & all<sup>00</sup> situate in Mountpleasant township Adams county surveyed July 4<sup>th</sup> 1772 on warrant dated June 30<sup>th</sup> 1772, now owned & possessed by George Lawrence. surveyed to Ludwick Schrieber.

August 21<sup>st</sup> 1837.

At the time of making the survey of the above land for the said Ludwick Schrieber in pursuance of the above recited warrant I then was possessed of a warrant for surveying the same land to Thomas McCreary dated April 15<sup>th</sup> 1772. But I thought it proper to give preference to the said Schrieber's warrant tho' of a posterior date in as much as the said Schrieber had applied unto and lodged money with George Stevenson on the 20<sup>th</sup> Sept. 1755 for the same land & had a survey made in pursuance of the same a short time afterwards.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this fourth day of February 1909.
