


FORM NO 1.



In pursuance of the several acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the Principal and Interest due to the Commonwealth from persons holding lands by virtue of locations or other office titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government and for other purposes, I have this day located & surveyed Application 5587 granted 28th August 1769 to Andrew Shuber for 200 ac in Huntingdon Township, on lands situate as aforesaid, and have found the interferences as represented in the enclosed diagram. Witness my hand.
