Upon request of William Hiscook Purchaser, yt I would grant him to take up two hundred be stilly acres in y = County of Chester. These are to will & require thee forthwith to survey or cause to be surveyed in ye remaining part of ye township of Concord the afore mentioned number of acres, according to ye method of townships by me appointed, & make return thereof into my Secretary Office. Given at Chester ye 6th of ye 12th month, 1682.
