At ye request of William Howell, Purchaser of five hundred acres
under Lewis David yt I would grant him to take up ye remaining two
hundred acres in ye County of Chester: These are to will & require thee
forthwith to survey or cause to be surveyd unto him ye sd number of acres
in ye afore mentioned county where not already taken up according to ye me-
thod of townships appointed by me and make returns thereof into my Secre-
tary's office. Given at Philadelphia ye 22^d of ye 3^d mo. 1684.
