By the Commissioners of Property.

Upon an agreement made with Samuel Guldin late of the Canton of Bern in Switzerland for eight hundred acres of land to be laid out in the township of Strasburg in the County of Chester for which he is to pay within six months after ye survey thereof of sixty pounds Sterling to the Proprietors use in London. These are to authorize and require thee forthwith to survey or cause to be surveyed to the said Samuel Guldin according to the method of Townships appointed the said quantity of eight hundred acres of land in the said township of Strasburg and make returns thereof into the Secretaries office which survey in case the said Samuel on his part fulfill the said agreement shall be valid, otherwise the same shall be void as if it had never been made nor this Warrt ever granted Given under our hands and the seal of the Province at Philadelphia the first day of the first month A. D. 1713⁹⁴.
