At ye Request of Henry Gibbs yt I would grant him to take up two hundred Acres of land at Susquahannah, & a Lott in ye town wher a Plot^l layd out for it. These are to will & require thee to survey or cause to be surveyd unto him ye said number of Acres & Lott (both w^{ch} I have freely given him ^{no} paying ye yearly quitrent as old purchasers do) & improving it according to regulations & make returnis thereof into my Secretary's Office. Given at Philadelphia ye 31st of ye 5th mmo. 1684.
