At ye request of Stephen Hough late Purchase of fifty acres of land yt I would grant him to take y^e up in ye County of Chester between Crum & Creek & Darby Creek: These are to will & require thee forthwth to survey or cause to be surveyed unto him ye sd number of acres in ye afore mentioned County, at or near ye place desired provided it be not already taken up, according to ye method of townships appointed by me, & make returns thereof into my Secretary's office. Given at Philadelphia ye 21st 9br. 1683.
