Upon an agreem<sup>t</sup> made with John Gregory of Edgmont township in the County of Chester for a vacant piece of land situate in the said township between the lines of Richard Adams and Evan Lewis their lands, for which he is to pay twenty pounds of the present currency upon or before the 29<sup>th</sup> day of September in the year one thousand seven hundred and ten to the use of the Proprietor. These are to authorize and require thee to survey or cause to be survey'd to the sd John Gregory the said piece of vacant land according to the lines of the lands adjacent bounding on the same, and make returns thereof into the Secretaries office. Given under our hand and seal of the said Province at Philadelphia the 29<sup>th</sup> day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & nine. It is Provided nevertheless that notwithstanding the Teste hereof, in case the sd Jno Gregory shall not comply with the agreem<sup>t</sup> aforesd this warr<sup>t</sup> & ye grant made thereby is to be utterly void & of no effect.
