By the Commissioners of Property.

Whereas at the time that the Township of Nottingham upon the Borders of this Province towards Maryland was first laid out by Henry Hollingsworth Surveyor of the same, a grant was made to him but no warrant issued for five hundred acres to be laid out adjoining to y^e said township, & to be held on y^e same terms with y^e rest of y^e lands included in that township w^{ch} he accordingly survey'd on y^e south side thereof, Now these are to authorize & require thee to return y^e sd survey as it was then made into the Secretaries office ~~and~~ in order to a further confirmation to y^e use of the said Henry Hollingsworth Provided that he the said Henry shall forthwith pay down all y^e arrears of rent due for the said land from y^e time of the said survey to this present year or in case he fails thereof then this warrant to be void. Given under our hands & seal of y^e Province at Philad^{ia} y^e 17th of 5th mo 1712.
