

N. W 410 percht,- to a marked post and from thence E b N. 60 percht- to a marked post and from thence S. S. E. 370 percht- to a marked gum standing by a branch side and over the branch on sev- erall corses to a marked post stand by the river side and from thence along downe the river to the first mentioned post.
