



Appell 3<sup>rd</sup> Anno 1683.

There layd out for Ifrances Harrison 250 acres of land leying on y<sup>e</sup> (obl.) side of Darnans Creek begining at a marked Beech, standing by a branch of the sd creeke being the esterndmost bounds of Thomas gorrots land and from thence runing S. W. 160 perches to a marked Beech being the wastermost bounds of Thomas garrots. and from thence runing S for 8 perches to a marked red oke from thence up a branch of the sd creek wasterly to a marked popler from thence N 100 perches to a marked Chesnute tree from thence E. 5 90 perches to a marked whitte oke from thence N.N.E 10 perches to a marked Beech tree from thence N.E 6. N 32 perches to a marked popler from thence N 60 perches to a marked red oke from thence N.N.E 34 perches to a marked whitte (obl.) being the corner tree of walter ~~of~~ Martens land
