

Pursuant to an order from James Logan Attorney for the Proprietaries
Daughter Latitia Penn now Latitia Aubry to lay out unto John Rentrow one hun-
dred ~~one~~ acres of land in the said Latitia's Mannor on the west side of
Brandywine Creek in the County of Delaware. There was surveyed and laid out
unto ~~one~~ Samuel Hall (to whom ye sd. Rentrow sold his right) the said
quantity of one hundred acres of land in ye said place Beginning at a Black
oak in a line of Marlborough township and running by the said line East 127
perches to a hickory tree Thenne south by vacant land 126 perches to a hick-
ery tree Then west by the land of Gacy Miller & other land 127 perches to a
Black oak Then north 126 perches to the place of the Beginning.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in
the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made
conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of
February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused
the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg,
this twelfth day of May 1909.
