


John Buds Land

By virtue of a warrant to me directed dated ye 1st 4th m: 1703 I have surveyed unto John Guest Esq^r A tract of land in ye County of Chester begining at a corner hickory thence by a line north 329 p. to a corner hickory being a corner of John Buds Land then his line west 324 pds. to a corner black oak in the line of Letticia Penn's Manner^r then south 329 pds. to a post then ^{East} by a line dividing them from vacant Lands East 324 pds to ye place of begining Containing 666 2/3 Acres. The 25th 10th 1703.
