By the Commissioners of Property.

At the request of Henry Hollingsworth That we would grant him a certain vacant tract of Barrens in the township of Providence and county of Chester situuate be-
tween the lands of George Smedly, David Ogden & Thomas Minshall adjoin-
ing on Ridly creek for which he has agreed to pay to the Proprietaries use ten
pounds for every hundred acres thereof and so proportionably: These are to re-
quire thee forthwith to survey and lay out to the sd Henry Hollingsworth the sd
tract of vacant Barrens bounded by the outlines of the lands surrounding it,
and make returns thereof into the General Surveyors office at Philadelphia
where this warrant is to remain and a copy thereof to be delivered to thee cer-
tified by the Secretary who is also to take a Duplicate of this return into
his office. Given under our hands and the seal of the Province at Philad-
elphia the 16th of the 12th 1701.
