

Surveyed for John Houlson 200 acres of land lying on the east side of Ridley creek beginning at a marked white oak being the corner tree of Randall Malins land standing by Ridley creek and running along the sd ^{NE N} Malins line 400 perches to a marked white oak and from thence N.N.W 100 perches to a marked ~~other than a white~~ white oak then S.W.S. 365 perches to a marked popler standing by Ridley creek and down the creek on several courses to the first mentioned white oak.
