These are to require thee forthwith to resurvey to the sd Richard Hayes the said two hundred and sixty acres situate as aforesaid and make returns thereof into the Surveyor Generals office at Philadelphia where this warrt is to remain and a copy thereof to be delvd thee certified by the Secretary who is also to take a duplicate of thy return into his office. Given under our hands and the seal of the Province at Philad^{ia} the 16th of ye 12th moth 1701.
