Lay'd out for John Otter and from thence W.S.W 555. Perches to a marked
sasafrice being the other corner tree of the afores^e Ott^r from thence N.N.W.
58 perches to a marked Red oke from thence E.N.E to a dede whitte oke
standing in a bottom now the sd Creek side from thence down the creek
to the first bound.
